All of the window and door frames are in place and the inner plastering is progressing very fast. The basement of the hotel is a scene of great activity, as many workmen are busy installing the ice and refrigerating machinery and the laundry equipment. On the ground level of the east wing is being installed one of the largest ice boxes with full cork insulation that has been constructed on the Gulf coast. In this part of the building will also be the kitchen, pantry and other catering equipment.

All of the plumbing and steam heating appliances are in, and the bathrooms are being tiled at a rate of about ten bathrooms a day.

Hal Thompson, president and manager of the Pine Hills hotel, expresses himself as being very well satisfied with the progress, and says he will have everything in readiness for the opening about Thanksgiving Day.
