

The \$50,000 damage suit instituted by Frank S. Norman, administrator of the estate of Arthur Caron, deceased, against the George J. Glover Company in the Harrison county circuit court, resulted in a verdict for the defendant following peremptory instruction from the court. The suit grew out of the death of Caron when a scaffold upon which he was at

work at the Pines Hills hotel fell to the ground.

A non-suit was entered this afternoon in the case of J. R. Alexander who sought \$15,000 from the Louisville and Nashville Railroad Company for alleged personal injuries. The company introduced claim agents from several railroads in an effort to prove that the plaintiff had sought damages for alleged personal injuries under more than one name. Daisy Cuave who sued the Pine Hills hotel for \$3000 for alleged personal injuries was awarded \$150.
